**Article 1: GOAL OF THE AGREEMENT:**

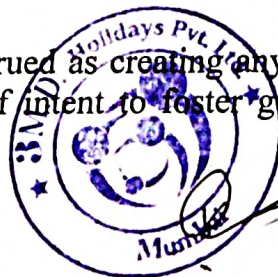
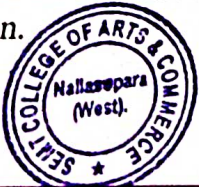

- Mentioned about every activity happening in the plant like washing of bottles, filling, capping, labeling and packaging.






