ATR Report and Achievement Report as Clean and Green Campus Initiative

Based on the principles and guidelines mentioned in the Green Policy of the institution, the college has planned Clean and Green campus activities such as environmental protection, waste management initiatives and clean energy usage within the college.

Following are the clean and green campus initiatives:

1. Increased the use of LED lights on campus to improve energy saving effects.
2. Installation of portable fire extinguishers at easily accessible places in the college to ensure safety of students and staff.
3. Installing bio-composting pits where garden waste or wet organic waste is collected and decomposed.

9. Celebration of various days to promote clean and green initiatives such as World Earth Day, Plastic Free Day, etc.
10. Workshops are conducted by the college to inculcate green practices among the students like Eco-friendly Ganesha Chaturthi, Air Pollution, 7R's, etc.
11. The introduction of the kitchen garden often works as an ecological practice.
