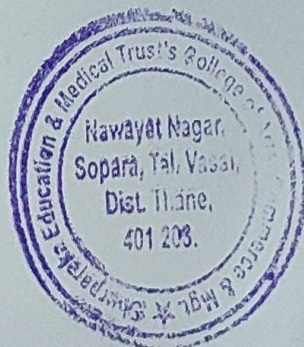


DOMESTIC VIOLENCE




ANTI-RAGGING


