- 11. Planning extracurricular and cocurricular activities at the departmental and committee (college) level

 - > To strengthen feedback and review mechanisms and action taken on all activities initiated.
 - > To organise workshops, seminars, conferences, and training programmes for and with fellow teaching and non-teaching staff members.
