## ANOVA Procedure: One-Way and Two Way

ANOVA is the statistical model that you use to predict a continuous outcome on the basis of one or more categorical predictor variables.

### Assumptions

Analysis of Variance assumes that

- 1) the observations on Y are independent,
- 2) populations being sampled are normal,
- 3) populations being sampled have equal variances

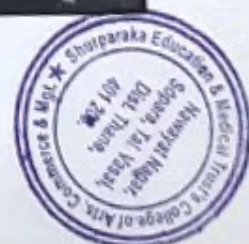
### One Way ANOVA:

Analysis of variance for a quantitative dependent variable of a single factor.

This is an extension of independent t-test when the number of levels of the factor is more than two. Typical assumptions are normality and constant variance for each level.

### Two Way ANOVA :

A two-way ANOVA test is a statistical test used to determine the effect of two nominal predictor(2 Factors) variables on a continuous outcome(dependent) variable. ANOVA stands for analysis of variance and tests for differences in the effects of independent variables on a dependent variable.
