Objectives of the Policy

1. To provide freeship to poor, needy, and deserving students by waiving their fees either fully or partly.
2. To provide financial support to needy and deserving students to participate in various NSS, cultural, and sports activities.

Policy Statement

Recognizing the difficulties poor students face in paying college fees due to limited financial resources, the management commits to supporting them to pursue higher education. Freeships are provided in the form of full or partial fee waivers based on students' requests and financial conditions. The college also sympathetically provides concessions in college fees to international students.


Procedure of the Policy

Students seeking freeship or concession submit written applications with complete details to the Management through the Principal. Once approved, the office implements the concession. If students approach the management directly, instructions are forwarded to the office for action.

Conclusion

The management provides freeships or concessions based on financial needs and applications. Depending on the situation, fees may be fully or partially waived.
