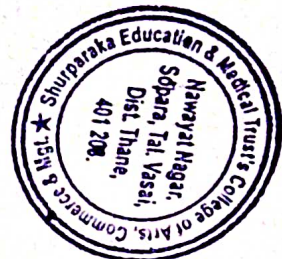



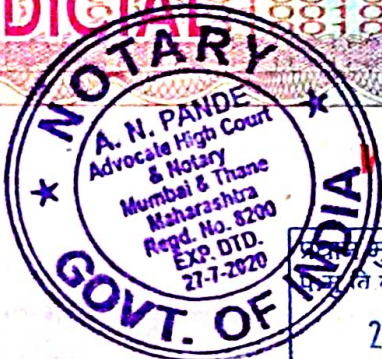

Party of the second part being a Trust that is operating an educational institute complex with available facilities and willing to use it for benefit of the students belonging to socially and economically weaker sections, the institute and the management are desirous of social wellness, and the undersigned being authorized signatory enters this MoU jointly with party of the first part.

A. These presentations are essentially a mutually agreed and mutually beneficial arrangement where the party of the second part is allowing use of their available infrastructure post the educational activities are completed for a day. D. The programs conducted by the party of the first part shall be vocational and employability skills centric and shall place minimum 50% of the candidates trained. Each candidate shall be given at least 3 opportunities to take up a job or vocation.

6. Arrange Trainers, admin staff and their remuneration

 - a. Free Course For Certification In Computer + Tally With GST Operating Course Of MSSDS Under NULM and SSDM Scheme
 - b. Free Course In Banking & Finance
 - c. Free Course In English Speaking & Soft Skills
8. VTP (Vocational Training Partner) programs
9. NULM (National Urban Livelihood Mission)
10. SSDM (State Skill Development Schemes) State run program
11. CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility initiative funded Schemes

F. Party of the second part will provide the following infrastructure separate without disturbing their other ongoing programs

7. Relevant permissions and cooperation from management team to conduct training programs



G. All official email and communication will be done with the email IDs and phone numbers mentioned in the signature section of these presents.

This is agreed upon by both the party as undersigned.

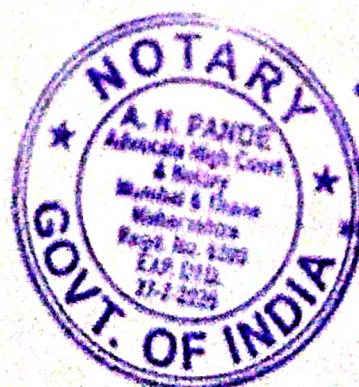

And

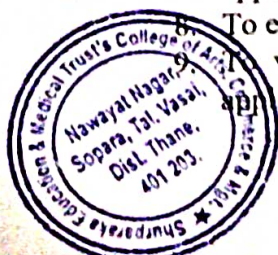

Article 1: GOAL OF THE AGREEMENT:

The goal of this MoU is the exchange of teaching personnel and students between both the institutions and in order to enhance cross-cultural understanding, learning, and sharing of knowledge mainly based on research and skill enhancement between the two institutions through research conferences, faculty development programmes and similar events based on case studies, conclaves, guest sessions, industry interactions and similar events.

1. There will be an exchange of faculties for the specific subjects whenever there will be a need base requirement.
2. Students and teachers will be invited for the various college level programs.
3. There will be lending of library books, Journals as per the request of concerned Principals.
4. To extend the co-operation to share the Professional Laboratory ethics.
5. To organize FDP on Research Methods and Techniques for Social Sciences.
6. To extend the on-hand training in professional laboratories.
7. To extend the co-operation in training the students to apply the theory knowledge at applied practical level.

To extend co-operation in project work, seminars, presentation, viva, orals etc.
work together for human values, professional ethics, importance of Industrial-
applied view, academic practices.



10. There will be a co-ordination between two colleges regarding the various administrative procedures, policies of Govt, of Maharashtra, University of Mumbai.
11. This M.O.U will be valid for next 5 years date of 31st May, 2024.

Article 5: ADHERENCE TO RULES & REGULATIONS

Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the rules and regulations of the institutions.

Article 6: COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:

The host institution bears no responsibility for providing funds to visiting faculty for any purpose other than those provided to its own faculty to support teaching, e.g., photocopying, telephone, and computer support. Except for salary and benefits, exchange faculty will be eligible for the usual faculty privileges by the host institution.

Article 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

Article 8: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of **FIVE YEARS** commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

Article 9: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

Article 10: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither Shurparaka Educational & Medical Trust's M.B. Harris College of Arts & A. E. Kalsekar College of Commerce & Management, nor Faculty of Law, Parul University(Gujarat), will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, Shurparaka Educational & Medical Trust's M.B. Harris College of Arts & A. E. Kalsekar College of Commerce & Management and Faculty of Law, Parul University(Gujarat), will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.
