ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

A: Faculty/Staff Exchanges

3. The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.





C. Linkages of Resource

3. To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
4. The provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes,
5. To use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period,
6. To permit students, staff, and faculty members to use the library facility.
7. To carry out major and minor research projects jointly

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Asst. Professor. ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY


